What is the Choose Your Own Assigned Solicitor Programme (“the Programme”)?

The Legal Aid Bureau (“LAB”), a department of the Ministry of Law, offers eligible applicants the option to choose their preferred lawyer (“Assigned Solicitor”) for their civil divorce cases (i.e. not for Syariah divorce cases).

How will this Programme benefit me?

This Programme is faster and simpler than the usual process. You do not need to explain your case to LAB first, which means that your chosen lawyer will be assigned to you more quickly.

Who can take part?

You can join the Programme if you wish to divorce your spouse and have not started court proceedings yet.

You cannot join this Programme if your spouse has started a divorce case against you. You will need to file your Notice to Contest at the Courts’ E-filing Service Bureau (located at the State Courts) within 14 days of receiving the court documents.

Once completed, you may come to LAB as we can still provide legal aid for your divorce case if you pass the means and merits tests.

Means Test: We check if your financial situation qualifies you for legal aid.

Merits Test: We review if your case has a fair chance of succeeding in Court.

How can I participate?

We'll guide you on your next steps during your appointment.

STEP 1

- Register your case on **LAB's Applicant Portal**.
- Complete the application and financial forms.
- Book an appointment with us via the **OneMinLaw Portal**.
- Attend your appointment so Counter Service Officers can check your eligibility.

* You will need a SingPass account. If you do not have one, please visit www.singpass.gov.sg, or visit any SingPass counter at a Community Centre near you to register.

STEP 2

- If you are eligible, you will receive the Programme letter and Assigned Solicitor (AS) list.
- Contact your preferred AS from our panel within 3 days.
- Book an appointment with the AS to discuss your case.
- If AS agrees to act for you, AS will submit the application to LAB on your behalf.

What if AS refuses to act for you?

- Make an appointment to see our Duty Officer via the OneMinLaw Portal.
- Attend your appointment

STEP 3

- Our officers will contact you to assess your eligibility through two steps:

3A: Means Test

PASS

- LAB will proceed to determine if your case has merit

Continue to Merits Test ▼

FAIL

You are ineligible for legal aid.

3B: Merits Test

PASS

- You will be informed of your results and if AS assignment is confirmed.
- You will need to pay contribution to LAB, where applicable
- AS starts working on your case.

FAIL

You are ineligible for legal aid.

What documents do I need to bring to the Assigned Solicitor for my first appointment?

Please bring all documents related to your case, including:

- Marriage Certificate and your Child(ren)'s Birth Certificate(s)
- Court documents (if you have any), including court documents from other cases involving your spouse (e.g. Expedited Orders, Personal Protection Orders, Maintenance Orders)
- Your Spouse's NRIC number and contact details
- Latest HDB/bank mortgage and CPF Public Housing statements (if you have them)
- Your Programme Letter (which will be given to you if you pass the preliminary means test)

What if I do not have a preferred Assigned Solicitor?

You can still apply directly with LAB by making an appointment to see our Duty Officer via the OneMinLaw Portal and we will assign a lawyer to you if you pass the means and merits tests.
