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STEP 1

Access our Applicant Portal http://go.gov.sg/mlawlabesvc or by scanning the QR code on the right:

If you are using a mobile device, tap on the 3 lines as shown in the screenshot below.

If you are using a desktop or a laptop, skip to the next step.









STEP 5

The "Make Statement" chatbot will be displayed.

You may click on the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQS) if you would like to find out more about the respective questions.

Otherwise, if you are ready to give your statement, you may click on "Yes, I'd like to make my statement and am willing to accept legal advice." A series of questions will appear. Please answer them as fully and accurately as you can.

Make Statement



You are about to make a statement regarding your case. This statement will be used to present your case to the Legal Aid Board for evaluation.

You can save a trip down to LAB by submitting your statement and all the supporting documents online.

Here are some FAQs to read before we start:

What happens after I have submitted? Will anyone contact me?

Once I submit, is the statement final? Can I still make changes?

Is there a deadline? When must I complete making my statement?

Should I only provide details that are favourable for me?

What if I don't have all the details or feel unsure how to answer the questions?

Looks like you're ready to start making your statement which will take around 30-40 minutes. Would you like to start now?

STEP 7

What are the advantages of completing the Online Statement ?

Completing your statement online saves you time as you can kickstart the process even before your appointment with the Legal Executive.

Moreover, there is increased convenience and flexibility as you are able to submit your statement anytime/anywhere, when it suits you.





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What is the timeline to complete my Online Statement?

You will receive a SMS and/or email notification to complete your Online Statement once you have passed the Means Test. Please complete your Online Statement within 4 working days from the date you passed Means Test.



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What should I prepare before attempting my Online Statement?

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Any documents relating to your case

You may refer to the examples below (please note that the lists are not exhaustive).

1. <u>**Divorce**</u>: Marriage Certificate, Birth Certificates and Personal Protection Order (PPO)/Maintenance related documents (if any).

2. <u>Enforcement/Variation of Court Order (EVC</u>): Court order.

3. <u>Letters of Administration (LA)/Probate</u>: Death Certificate, Documents relating to Deceased's Assets (E.g. Bank Book, Insurance Policies) and Will of Deceased (if any).

4. <u>Syariah Court Divorce (SYC)</u>: Case Statement, Memorandum of Defence, Proposed Parenting Plan, Proposed Matrimonial Property Plan, Court Notice and any other supporting documents.

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How do I submit my online statement if I do not have a computer?

You may use your smartphone to complete your Online Statement.

Alternatively, you may use the computer terminals at:

a. The Ministry of Law Services Centre (MSC) located at 45 Maxwell Road, #07-11, The URA Centre East Wing, Singapore 069118; or

b. Our partnered Community Clubs (CC). The locations of the CCs can be found by visiting the weblink <u>here</u> or scanning the QR code below:



What happens after I submit my Online Statement?

> The Legal Executive in charge **A** of your case will review your Online Statement that was submitted. If no further clarification is needed, the Online Statement will be submitted to the Legal Officer in charge of your case for review. If clarification is required, the Legal Executive will call you on the appointment date.
